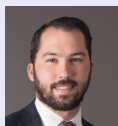

### Limitations on Subcontracting

Revised FAR coverage standardizes the limitations on subcontracting that apply to small businesses. For all programs, the amount spent on “similarly situated entities” does not count against the “limitation on subcontracting.”

### Good Faith Subcontracting

FAR revisions provide guidance on assessing whether a contractor has made a good faith effort to comply with its small business subcontracting plan. Failure to make a good faith effort is a material breach and subject to liquidated damages.

### Procurement Scorecard

SBA’s 15<sup>th</sup> “Procurement Scorecard” shows the government exceeded its small business contracting goal of 23 percent (actual 26 percent) and its subcontracting goal of 29 percent (actual 32 percent).

### Contract Requires the Use of U.S.-Flagged Vessels

The Armed Services Board of Contract Appeals determined that the government contracting officer properly denied a contractor’s non-compliant request to use a foreign-flag vessel and the government was entitled to an equitable adjustment in the contract price.
